BENEFITS OF SUPPORT GROUPS

People who care for loved ones with dementia are susceptible to cumulative stress due to the increasing responsibilities of their role. As a result, most caregivers are at an above average risk of stress-related illness.

Our educational support groups are designed to help caregivers adapt to their roles in ways that are both hopeful and effective. In addition to taking a break and socializing with others, caregivers appreciate the opportunity to talk through difficult choices.

Our groups focus on positive strategies for handling specific challenges and provide information about community resources. Most caregivers report feeling relieved after attending a support group.

Those who attend educational support groups often report feeling more satisfied with their choices and confident in their caregiving skills.
